Interpretation of Site	Heritage Inventory Interpretation: Series of features relating to mid nineteenth century rural settlement in the Lake Boga area. Large number of Aboriginal sites (continuous scatters and patches of materials across the site) combined with vast scatters of glass and ceramics over similar area suggests possible contact associations. (1 positive glass scraper identified with invasive retouch along one margin)

Heritage Inventory History of Site:
1848- Reedy Lake squatting run taken up by Curlewis and Campbell. 1849- Taken over by W. Splatt. 1851- Reedy Lake subdivided, Murrabit formed on land. 1851- Lake Boga Aboriginal Reserve and Mission Paddock

Gazetted. 1856- Mission closure. 1856/7- Mission land incorporated into C.H. Edden's Murrabit P.R. 1858/62- Managed, then owned, by T.A. Browne. 1863 onwards- successive rural owners.
