History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The New Sultan Company was a spectacularly unsuccessful mining venture of the early 1880s. This company, which took over a lease once held by the Mounter Brothers, and the Township Reef Company (late Sultana Company), installed a very large and expensive mining plant. Within two years the company had closed down and the plant was being removed from the mine: ie., September 1883 it was reported that the last remaining plant - a 80hp engine, chilian mill, pumping gear and a chimney stack - was in the process of being removed from the site.
