History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: This was the site of an apple drying factory, built in 1908, but destroyed by fire. it was rebuilt in brick in 1910. In 1921 the site was purchased by Ernest Blume, who used the old factory as a bakery and constructed a large brick house. The bakery was operating until 1960.
