History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: Around 1868, the Rising Sun Quartz Mining Company, formerly Veal and party, erected steam-powered mining machinery to work Frenchmans Reef, which was located in Blind Creek, near Specimen Hill. It appears to have been a short-lived venture and it was not until the discovery of the Rising Star line of reef by Roller & Massiminos party in 1877 that the Blind Creek area experienced any significant mining.
